WingX Pro7 Adds Support for ADS-B Out and FAA-Certified GPS Data

In addition, route changes made on the panel-mounted system will automatically update the active route in WingX Pro7.

The FAA has mandated ADS-B Out in all U.S. aircraft by 2020. The NavWorx ADS600-B is a remote-mounted universal access transceiver that sends ADS-B Out information and receives ADS-B In information including ADS-B, ADS-R and TIS-B traffic and FIS-B weather. Airplanes equipped with ADS-B Out have superior situational awareness because they are able to receive more complete ADS-B traffic information.
